Together, we review and develop material for the Welcome Center.

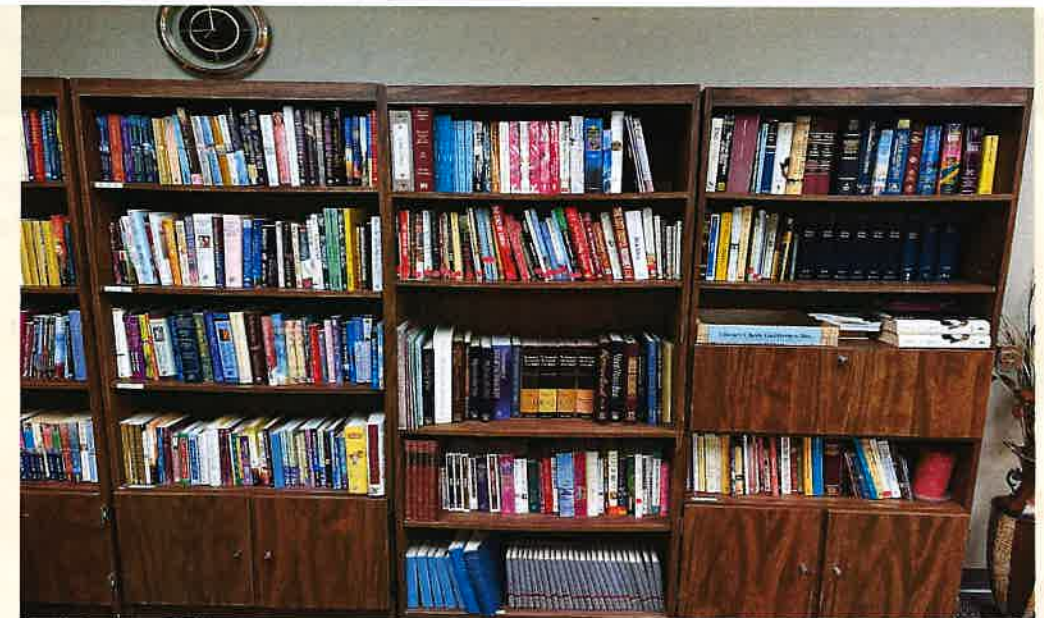

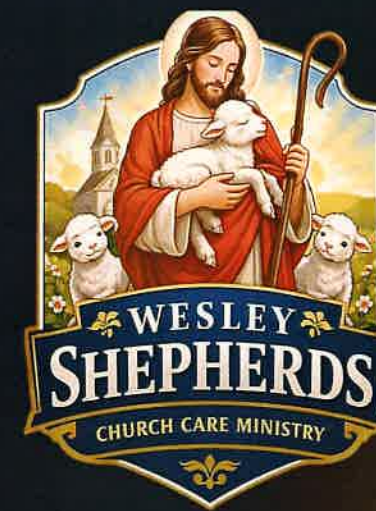
